polyethylene terephthalate

soft drink bottles, mineral water, fruite juice container, cooking oil high-density polyethylene

milk jugs, cleaning agents, laundry detergents, bleaching agents, shampoo bottles, washing and shower soaps polyvinyl

trays for sweets, fruit, plastic packing (bubble foil) and food foils to wrap the foodstuff low-density polyethylene

The first polyethylene terephthalate (PET) bottle was recycled in 1977

Recycling a ton of PET containers saves 5.6 cubic meters of landfill space.
